1. Welcome and Apologies for Absence

5. Audited Accounts

The Council's audited accounts were submitted and agreed.

6. Defibrillator

The clerk noted that the East of England Co-op had offered a defibrillator either for the Parish Council to locate itself or subject to survey, to be placed on its shop at Riverside in Scarning. It was noted that Scarning School had offered to locate a defibrillator in the front porch of the old school building.

It was agreed to use Parish Council funds to purchase a defibrillator to be sited at the school and to ask the East of England Co op to site a second defibrillator outside its Riverside shop. It was also agreed that the Parish Council will step back and allow the Village Hall Trust to apply for funding on its own for a defibrillator to be placed outside the Village Hall.
